Chapelle's listing from *The National Watercraft Collection*

This listing of domestic built ships in the National Watercraft Collection is extracted from: Howard I. Chapelle, 1960, *The National Watercraft Collection*, United States National Museum Bulletin 219, Washington, DC: Smithsonian Institution. The surprising number of downeast-built ships listed in the watercraft collection, in contrast to the lack of surviving half models of Bath, Maine or Massachusetts-built ships (other than Newburyport), provides a startling insight into the extent by which Maine communities participated in the booming shipbuilding economy of mid-19th century Maine.

Abbreviations: C – coasting (coastwise trade); F – foreign trade (transoceanic); L – lumber; Sch – schooner; 2MSch – two-masted schooner; 3MSch – three-masted schooner; SQTPS – square topsail; WI – West Indies.
